2008


- 5 small municipalities, 36 000 inhabitants

- Also larger cities and regions have joined
  - > Tampere, Turku, Lahti, Vantaa; Pirkanmaa, Päijänne Tavastia

# **Ambitious goals**

#### GHG emissions -80 % by 2030 from 2007 levels


- Includes all activity within municipal borders (excl. industry under the EU emissions trading scheme ETS)
- Electricity, heating, transportation, agriculture and waste management

#### Schedule much slower in the EU

 -55% by 2030 and carbon neutral by 2050 from 1990 levels






# Hyvinkää consumption-based climate emissions

Emissions of imported goods and services are also included: → Roughly <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of Finland's household emissions are directed abroad






