On Wednesday morning 6 February we will visit the Smart Village of Lantula (<http://www.lantula.fi/>), about 20 minutes bus drive from the hotel. Over the years, Lantula has implemented a series of LEADER projects that have enabled the renovation of the Village House from a closed down school building, re-cycling unit for the household waste, thermal energy solution for the Village House, a youth gathering place, elderly services like Friday lunches etc.
